HOW TO REGISTER

1. Go to www.lscacamp.org.
2. On the top menu, click Summer Camp drop down menu, or LSCA Account Login if you have previously set up an account. For returning accounts, please skip to #4 after clicking "LOGIN".
3. For new users, Click "Registration Information" then click on the session name that you want to register for, this will open up all of the information about this session of camp. Click "register for this Session".
4. If you have an account, login here or if you do not have an account, create an account (this is the parent / guardian and family).
5. Click "Add a Person" for each camper in your family, unless the camper is already on the account from a previous year. Select camper you wish to register.
6. Select "make reservation" then select the desired session of camp.
7. Answer all questions on form: church membership, health History, medications, contact info, pick up authorizations, etc.
8. Click "Proceed to Check out" after donations page then click "Proceed to Payment"
9. When you get to payment method, select "Sponsorship Code" and enter the code from church if applicable, then follow prompts to pay balance or select payment plan. You must complete the ENTIRE payment portion to complete the registration whether paying with credit card, check or waiting for scholarship. If you plan to pay with check or are waiting on a scholarship, select pay with check. And click "COMPLETE ORDER" at end.

Traditional Overnight Camp

Traditional overnight camp started at LSCA in 1939. These camps get longer as the campers get older. These include: 1st Chance, Trailblazers, Explorers, Juniors, Junior High, Niners and High School Camp. With the exception of 1st Chance camp, which will begin at 9am on its start day, the rest of these camps will begin with a 3pm check in on their start day. All of the camps will end at 4pm on their last day. At 4pm, there might be a short closing program and baptisms, etc. Each of these camps is designed for your camper to learn and grow and thrive. Campers will stay in air-conditioned dorms. They will also have multiple snack times each day called Canteen.

Discovery Camps 1-7

Discovery Camps will run each week Monday thru Friday. This is for 2nd thru 4th grade campers. Each day will run from 830am to 5pm—no overnight stay. Campers are invited to attend multiple weeks. Campers bring a sack lunch and have a great week discovering God and His creation and new friends. This camp will take place at LSCA's Lakeview Lodge. Each camper will get a t-shirt. This is a great option for parents looking for something for their camper to do all summer long.

Wilderness Camps

LSCA partners with Discovery Ministries in Eminence, MO to provide a real wilderness experience for the High School trip. These campers will take a trip in the Ozark Mountain area. This could include paddling, backpacking, caving, and climbing. Adult campers will enjoy a canoe trip in the Boundary Waters in Northern Minnesota as we partner with Coldwater Foundations. Both outfitting ministries provide guides, expertise and all the necessary gear!

Introductory Camps

For our youngest campers we have 2 types of introductory programs. For pre-K and K campers, we invite them to Hello Camp 1 and 2. They bring one of their adults to experience 3 hours of camp with them. Also, the camper gets a t-shirt. For campers going into 1st grade, we invite them to Day Camp, a full 8 hours of camp, independent from their adults.

Adventure Camps

These are perfect for the camper who loves to be outside and enjoys a smaller crowd. These will all be on the far north end of camp at Cypress Cove. Drop off and pick up will be at the Cypress Cove location. Most campers can count on sleeping in tents (provided by LSCA), enjoying time around the fire, and learning about God and His creation. There is Fishing Camp for boys (they stay in the dorm, not tents). There is also Adventure Camp 5-6 and Adventure Camp 7-8 for boys and girls. Some of these sessions have canteen cards (snack punch cards). Some have snacks included.

REGISTRATION REMINDERS:

- Youth campers attend based on their grade in the Fall of 2020.
- **Please only register campers for whom you are the legal guardian.** Youth campers cannot be registered under your account, unless you are the parent /legal guardian.
- Limited financial assistance is available. You will be prompted to apply (if necessary) during the registration process.
- Canteen time is snack time. Canteen cards are pre-purchased "punch" cards. The campers will have the opportunity to use their punches on various drinks and snacks at the designated times. If they choose not to, every unused "punch" is considered a \$1 donation to the summer resident missionary.

Special Interest Camps

Archery Camp: this is a weeklong, day time, instruction filled, archery adventure. 830am to 5pm daily, the campers will learn archery and hone their skills... novice to experienced. Each day the archers will meet at Cypress Cove. **Arts Camp:** this is a 3 day, day time, instruction filled camp for those interested in Woodworking, Performing Arts, and Culinary Arts.

Medical Professionals are on the grounds during youth camps to dispense all meds (OTC and Rx) and provide first aid as necessary.
